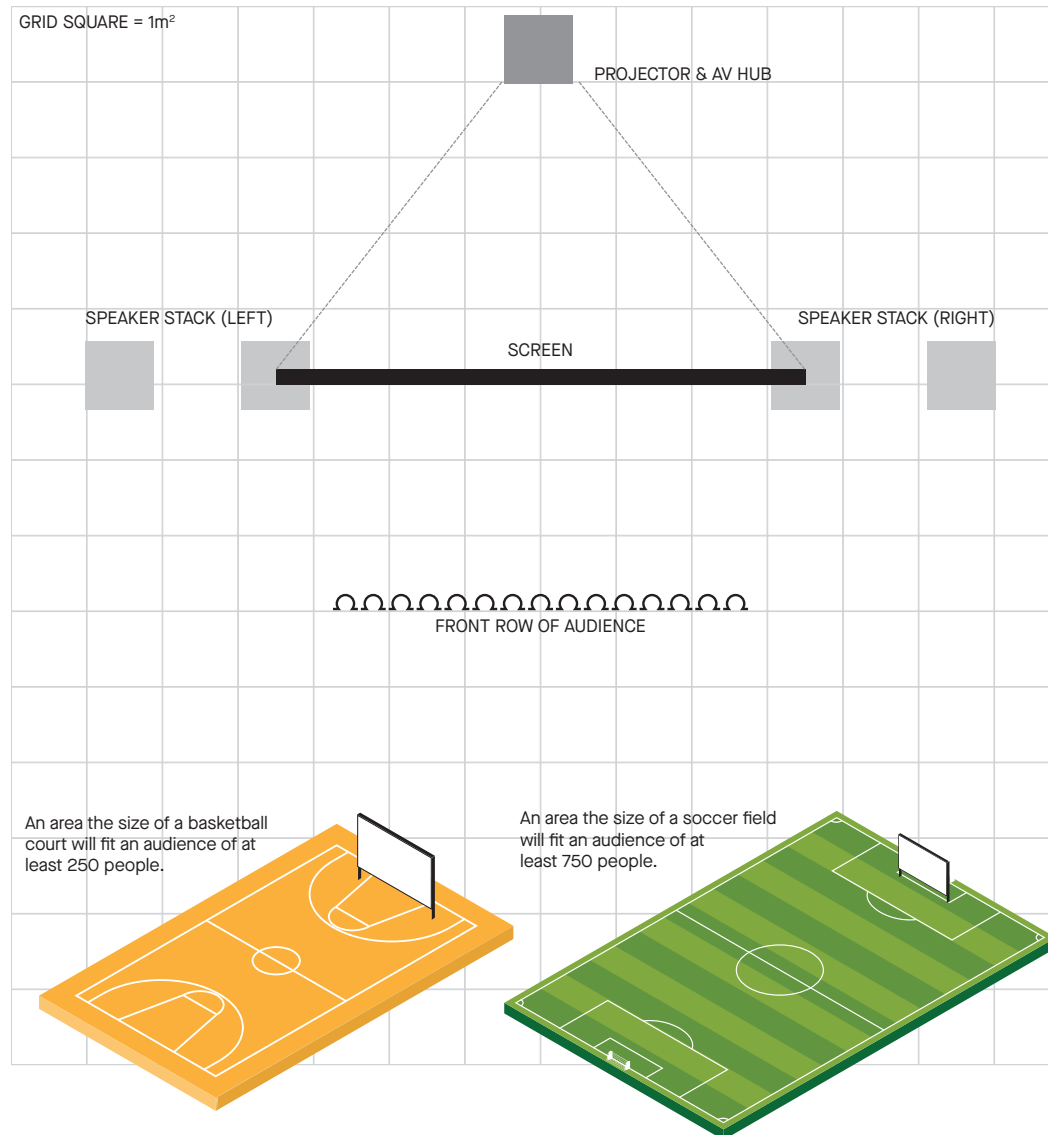

POP UP CINEMA STAGING NOTES



FRONT OR REAR PROJECTION

Pop Up Cinema uses a projection system for our events. The projector can be placed either in front of the screen or behind the screen.

Front projection

The advantage of front projection is a slightly brighter image, particularly where ambient lighting is an issue, and potentially more protection for the screen in high winds.

The disadvantage is that the audience cannot be closer than 7 metres from the screen to accommodate the projector/AV hub.

Rear projection

When conditions are favourable we will use rear projection. In this set-up there are no cables in front of the screen and the front row of the audience can be just 3 metres from the screen. The space between the front row and the screen can also be used for presentations or as a dancefloor.

OTHER STAGING FACTORS

Power

We require 2 independent 240v 10 amp power outlets. If these are not readily available we can deploy 2 x 3KvA generators.

Vehicle access

The closer we can bring our vehicle to the event site, the easier and less costly the deployment is likely to be.
